

Battle Rules – Play Fair, Play Safe, Have Fun!

Main Rule: Have Fun and Play Fair!

- Be respectful, play safely, and follow the rules in both letter and spirit—don't look for loopholes!
- If you're unsure about something, ask a Ref before doing it.
- 1. Listen to the Refs!
- Referees have the final say on all rules and calls. Follow their instructions.
- 2. No Physical Contact!
 - No pushing, kicking, punching, or any other physical contact.
 - Breaking this rule can result in expulsion from the game.
- 3. No Intentional Headshots!
 - Aim for the body, not the head. Accidents happen, but don't aim high on purpose.
- 4. Always Wear Eye Protection!
 - Goggles or glasses must be worn in combat zones at all times.
- 5. Hit = Out!
 - If a dart hits any part of your body, you're out—call it honestly!
 - Blaster hits do not count.
 - If two players hit each other at the same time, both are out.
- 6. Stay Inside the Battle Zones!
- Do not leave the play area unless a Ref or parent gives you permission.
- 7. Take Care of the Darts!
 - Avoid stepping on, bending, or damaging the darts.
- 8. Respect the Blasters!
 - Do not throw or drop blasters.
 - If you don't know how to use a blaster, ask for help.
 - If a blaster jams, get a Ref to fix it-don't force it.
- 9. Follow the Rules or Sit Out!
 - If you break the rules, you may be benched or asked to leave.
- 10. Play Honestly & Respawn!
 - If you're hit, call it out and respawn—cheating ruins the game for everyone!

NERF FAQ

1. What clothes should I wear? a. Sporty attire, pockets, and a closed toed tennis shoes (No Flip Flops or crocs). 2. Can I bring Ball ammo/short-dart blasters? a. Only 13+, must not shoot players within 5-10Ft 3. Can I have a private nerf game? a.No. We are however working on creating a Nerf **Birthday Party option.** 4. What if my child has physical or mental impairments? a. Everyone is welcome to participate! However, direct supervision of a chaperone is required. 5. Can I bring more than one blaster? a. Absolutely! If you would like to bring a spare to share as well that is also welcome! 6. What Kind of blaster is allowed? a. Any size or ammo type, but only elite and rival ammo is provided by us. (#2 is the rules for rival)

Suggestions on what to bring & what to avoid: Water bottle, eyewear with anti-fog, knee pads, and extra Ammo for non-elite dart or rival blasters

For younger players avoid complicated blasters that may cause jams such as belt fed ammo, rotating mechanisms or magazines.



We provide elite and rival only!

Elite dart: The standard all brand dart for the last decade!

N1 dart: Please Note: nerf is trying to update their standard dart and most new nerf brand blasters in stores will use this. Rival round: 13+ use only, with 5ft minimum rule



Mega Dart: larger darts exist and are also not provided



We allow all darts but can't provide them all. Half/Pro dart: 13+ use only, with 10ft minimum rule



Hyper round: 13+ use only, with 10ft minimum rule
